RBR operations not affected by Cyclone Idai

RBR (ASX: RBR) notes the fall in its share price in late trading yesterday and speculation published online around the same time which suggested that the Company's operations in Mozambique may have been impacted by the recent cyclone there.

RBR advises that Cyclone Idai hit the city of Beira, ~700km north of the capital of Maputo, where RBR is based. Beira is ~1200km south of the location of the proposed LNG projects to which RBR plans to provide its services.

As a result, the cyclone has had no impact on RBR's property or its operations.

The Company also notes the proponents of the LNG projects have stated that there was no immediate impact on their operations or the project area in general.

RBR continues to make strong progress with its preparations to be a major supplier of labour, training and other essential services to the country's LNG construction industry.

RBR Directors and Management extend their deepest sympathies to the families and friends of those who lost their lives in Cyclone Idai and to the many Mozambicans who have lost their homes and other personal possessions.
