RBR Group expands footprint in Mozambique via further investment in Temane

 RBR Group entities to build, own and operate Modular Building Assembly Facility and Workforce Accommodation & Training Camp at Temane.

RBR Group Limited ("RBR" or "Company") via operating entities Projectos Dinamicos ("PD") and Futuro Skills ("FS") is expanding its footprint in Temane, Mozambique to take advantage of the accelerating development of the significant SASOL Gas Projects in the south of the country.

PD and FS have moved quickly to enhance their presence and service capabilities in the expanding Gas project in Temane, Inhambane Province, Mozambique following the contract award to PD for a temporary works project announced 20 September 2022.

The initial contract for the Design, Supply, and Installation of Temporary Facilities for a subcontractor to the global chemicals and energy company SASOL of circa US\$2.0 million is the first of several that PD will target as further Requests for Tender are released.

Having completed an in-house feasibility and financial assessment PD has signed off on establishing a Modular Building Assembly Facility ("MBA Facility") and Workforce Accommodation Camp in Temane Mozambique.

Stage 1 of the camp will encompass a 100-person accommodation, training and leisure facility utilising the camp assets already owned by PD and previously stored in the city of Pemba following removal from the Wentworth camp in northern Mozambique.

The MBA Facility will be able to assemble purpose built, prefabricated and modular buildings for the various Oil & Gas, mining, and construction projects happening throughout Mozambique.

The Company has acquired tenure on a 2-hectare property strategically located within 2km of the main SASOL project area to locate the facility which will include a Workforce Accommodation Camp for rental to the various Contractors to the upcoming Gas and Power Projects in the area.

In addition, skills training and labour supply specialist FS will relocate its mobile training assets and establish a full-service training facility within the camp for training locals seeking employment with the various operators and subcontractors to the US\$800 million gas expansion project.

The Camp and MBA Facility (as depicted) will incorporate:

- •Restaurant & Bar
- •Pool and leisure Area
- Gym
- •Barbeque area
- ●Phase 1 100 Ensuite Rooms
- ●Phase 2 as required.

PD are confident that the investment in the Temane facilities will significantly enhance the group profile and capabilities to secure more orders from the upcoming projects.

RBR Executive Chairman Ian Macpherson said: "The significant developments in Temane offer the RBR operating entities the opportunity to refocus our service provision across our divisions of skills training, labour supply and labour accommodation whilst the developers of the world class Cabo Del Gado LNG projects reset their construction plans and timeframes for recommencement of those projects.

We have the assets, both skills training and camp infrastructure and the personnel to proceed with construction and are excited by the opportunity presented in Temane. With the expected cashflows from the initial PD contract award and existing capital reserves the Group is able to fund this new MBA Facility and Camp project internally."
